
Setting up DDNS

Follow the written instructions below, use images in the right hand column for reference.

1. After logging onto the DVR using Internet Explorer, click on the "Setup" button.
 2. Click on "DDNS" tab.
 3. Change DDNS Select to: <http://www.no-ip.com>.
 4. Click on "Create Account".
 5. Create a username (4-16 characters) and click on "Check" to see if it is available.
 6. Enter your e-mail address.
 7. Create a password (6-32 characters) and confirm password.
 8. Enter your first name, last name, and postal code.
 9. Review the terms of service available at <http://www.no-ip.com>. Then check box next to "You agree to the TOS".
 10. Click on "Next".
 11. Create a desired hostname.
 12. Select "cedyn.com" from the list of domains.
 13. Click "Next".
 14. Account information will be displayed.
 15. Click "OK".
 16. Information will be automatically entered into the DVR.
 17. You may now connect to the DVR using the DDNS host name that you created.
- Note:** If the DVR is connected to a router, the HTTP port used in the DVR must be forwarded in the router to the DVR's IP address using TCP and UDP protocol.
- If the HTTP port has been changed from the default of 80, it must be entered after the DDNS host name with a colon : and then the port number.


